Minutes general assembly Siena

Report of the General assembly, Siena, 28-05-02 (76 participants)

1. The report of the general assembly published in the newsletter of 2001 is accepted without comments
2. The report of the meeting secretary: The present meeting in Siena is the largest of the society so far: at least 450 attendants. The goal to have many more young colleagues presenting their work is successful. In 2003 there will be a ESP meeting in Ljubljana. The EAHP will organize a short course (topic: spleen) and a symposium and slide seminar (topic of both: aggressive lymphomas). In October of 2003 the workshop of the SH will take place in Memphis (topic: pediatric hematopathology).
3. The possible topics, extranodal hematolymphoid neoplasms and the integration of molecular results in hematolymphoid neoplasms are discussed. It is decided that the executive committee will make a definitive choice.
4. The new members Bridget Wilkins, John Vanderwalt, Lorenzo Leoncini and Elisabeth Ralfkiaer are acclaimed by the members. Also Harald Stein is confirmed to be the president, Miguel Piris as the president elect and Elias Campo as the meeting secretary. There is also support for Bettina Borrish who will be proposed as member of the the next executive committee. There are words of thank to the members who leave the executive committee: Carlo Baroni, Nina Hurwitz, Kaarle Fransilaa and Peter Isaacson. There is a special thank you for Peter Isaacson, from whom we are certain to hear more in the future.
5. Thessaloniki is presented by Konstantin Papadimitriou: the meeting promises to be not only scientifically promising, but also cultural and relaxing (the meeting place is right at the beach).
6. The proposal to host the 2006 meeting in Vienna by Andreas Chott is accepted with acclaim.
7. It is suggested to have the presentations of the meeting on a CD ROM. This proposal is certainly welcomed, but a problem might be that unpublished results may not be presented anymore. The executive committee will look into this.
