Society for Hematopathology (SH) Pathologist-in-Training Award Nomination Form

The Hematopathology Pathologist-in-Training Award is given each year to a fellow, resident or medical student who presents an outstanding paper related to hematopathology at the annual USCAP meeting. The nominee must be in one of the trainee categories mentioned above at the time the paper/abstract is submitted. Previous winners are not eligible. Papers are judged by a committee composed of members of the Executive Committee of the Society, and scored for scientific approach, significance, and presentation. Both oral and poster presentations are eligible. All poster nominees must be with their posters during the official poster sessions to discuss their work with the judges in order to be eligible for the award. Each winner receives a \$500 award.

To nominate a trainee for the SH Pathologist-in-Training Award, please complete the following information and fax or email to the Society's headquarters at the number/email address given below. *(If you are emailing the form and do not have an electronic signature, please confirm in the cover note that you are nominating the trainee.)* Nominations are due no later than 30 days prior to the first day of the USCAP annual meeting date. For this coming year, that date is February 4, 2017. Trainees with posters accepted for the Stowell-Orbison competition in the Hematopathology category are automatically nominated for the Society for Hematopathology Pathologist-in-Training Award and do NOT need to submit this additional application.
